Future of Water Act of 2022 Organizational Endorsements

Dear Members of Congress,

We, the below 266 organizations, endorse the Future of Water Act of 2022 from Senator Elizabeth Warren and Representative Ro Khanna.

The legislation would:

- (1) affirm that water is not a commodity. It would amend the Commodity Exchange Act to exclude "water or water rights (or any index, measure, value, or data related to water or water rights)" from the definition of a commodity.
- (2) ban water futures trading. It would amend the Commodity Exchange Act to include "water or water rights (or any index, measure, value, or data related to water or water rights)" on the list of futures dealings that are prohibited and subject to punishment as a misdemeanor crime and fined.

Water is a public trust resource on which everyone depends for life, and it must be managed and protected for public benefit.
